Estyn Report Published

Dear Parents,

As you will be aware, Llantrisant Primary School was inspected during the week beginning the 26 February 2024. A team of a total of 5 inspectors carried out a range of activities over 4 days, including lesson observations, book reviews, scrutiny of documents and meetings with pupils, parents, governors, senior and middle leaders, teachers and support staff. The full inspection report along with the parents and carers report is available on our school website and on Class dojo.

I am pleased to inform you that the inspection team was incredibly impressed by what they saw and the report highlights many strengths across all areas of school life focusing on the high priority placed on pupil well-being and developing a sense of belonging, commenting that our school **'develops highly nurturing and positive working relationships with pupils which supports pupils' progress effectively.'**

The report mentions that we are a reflective school that has **'high expectations'** and **'strives for success'**. Estyn recognised that we provide **'a safe and stimulating environment for pupils'** where **'pupils behaviour is exemplary'**, and **'leaders place happiness and learning at the heart of the school's work'**. They were particularly impressed with our approach to the school's curriculum commenting that, **'pupils are provided with valuable experiences that enrich their learning'**. Teaching is reported as being **'creative and engaging, providing pupils with exciting opportunities to develop their creative and artistic skills.'**

The report also highlights that pupils **'enjoy being at school,'** and **'display good concentration skills, they show perseverance and develop their problem solving and thinking skills well'**. Estyn also recognised the significant work undertaken by the school in developing pupil voice commenting that **'the school encourages all pupils to take on responsibilities through participation in pupil voice groups'** which **'develops pupils citizenship skills through contributing to the school community'**. and pleasingly, the report has identified how we **'celebrate diversity and raise awareness of pupils' different cultural backgrounds'**.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all staff who work with passion and care every day in providing the best possible opportunities for our pupils and to my governing body for their strategic contribution and support they give. To our pupils, my sincere thanks for everything that they bring to the school and to you as parents/carers for your continued support. It takes all the people mentioned above to make the school what it is today. You will not be surprised to know however, that we collectively remain ambitious for even further improvement going forward.
